Pentacel is a combined vaccine that includes DTaP, Hib, and IPV used at 2, 4 & 6 months

Quadracel is a combined vaccine that includes DTaP & IPV used at 4 years

MMRV is a combined vaccine that includes MMR & VZV used at 4 years

Rota is an oral vaccine

HPV is a 2 dose schedule if started before age 15, 3 doses if started after age 15

A yearly influenza vaccine is recommended starting at 6 months of age
